**DRUG DESCRIPTION**

Endovet® Multivitaminated is a broad-spectrum antiparasitic effective against internal and external parasites and enriched with liposoluble vitamins A, D, E; its active component ivermectin belongs to the avermectins group.

Endovet® Multivitaminated is recommended for treating internal and external parasitosis caused by gastrointestinal, pulmonary, kidney and eye nematodes during their larval and adult phases. It's also recommended against ectoparasites such as scabies spreading acari and house fly larvae, it's also recommended for treating vitamins A, D, E deficiencies in Dairy Cattle, sheep, goats and swine.

Endovet® Multivitaminated Due to its concentration less injections are needed which makes easier administering to a large group of animals.

Endovet® Multivitaminated has a tripe action: it deworms, achieves a long lasting effect for up to 70 days against nematodes and enriches with vitamins with only one injection it is safe and can be used in gestating and milking females, studs and young animals without any side effects.

Endovet® Multivitaminated decreases the risk of parasitic infestations by contaminated fields and paddocks.

Endovet® Multivitaminated helps avoid excessive use of the animals therefore decreases stress. Production parameters are improved as well as the physical aspect of the animal. Its use decreases the number of treatments a year. In can be used along vaccines.

## **DRUG USE**

Vitamin enriched broad-spectrum anthelmintic useful against hematophagous lice, scabies spreading acari and ticks in Dairy Cattle, sheep, goats and swine.

## **DOSAGE**

Dairy Cattle: 1 mL per 100 kg

Sheep and Goats: 0.5 mL per 50 kg Swine: 1 mL per 66 kg.

Frequency: Against nematodes one treatment every 3 to 4 months is advised, every new animal in the group must be treated. For treating ectoparasites repeat the treatment after 30 days. The number of shots depend on existent or non existent reinfestation or on the veterinarian's prescription.

## **ROUTE OF ADMINISTRATION**

Intramuscular

## **DRUG WARNINGS**

Injection spot may get swollen in some animals but it's temporary and doesn't require treatment.

## **WITHDRAWAL PERIOD**

Meat withdrawal: 42 days Do not use in animals that produce milk for human consumption.

Keep this product in a cool and dry place protected from light at a temperature between 15° and 30 °C Aquatic organisms are highly sensitive to ivermectin, therefore empty containers and any residue must be disposed of by burying or incinerating.

Keep out of reach of children and pets.
